Cell Phone Policy

2nd-5th Grade Students are able to possess cell phone devices to support safety before and after school. Cell phones must be turned off and cannot be visible on campus during the school day. Violations will result in the phone being confiscated and the following:

1st Offense: 7 day waiting period OR \$15 administrative fee

2nd Offense: 30 day waiting period AND \$15 administrative fee

3rd Offense: Phone returned after the end of the school year AND \$15 administrative fee
